The outdoor spaces have been created as various 'landscape courts' to provide the desired functional requirement as well as aesthetic ambience.

Entrance court is adorned with the inviting wind chime on the Peltophorum tree and houses a seat court for parents with landscape around.





The space between the Temple & the Nakshatra Path is designed as a theme garden with various statues and stone sculptures as focal points and patterned flower gardens.

Nakshatra Path is designed as a sheltered walkway for the devotees to access the temple.

Done in a traditional way with tile roofing, clerestory lighting and granite flooring, this provides the devotees with a divine experience.

The bio swale, in a meandering pattern runs around the temple premises collecting the storm water all around.

The grand water fall pours water on to the upper pond.

Water travels from the upper pond, travels around the site and reaches the lower pond by gravity.

The water from the lower pond is pumped up to the upper basin of the water fall to complete the cycle.

The Ecopond, located at the lowermost level of the entire region collects all the storm water during the monsoon from the whole region. This ecopond has been done without any concrete / masonry structure and is surrounded with serene landscape, home to many birds.

The Ecopond serves as a water reservoir for the entire region and caters to the irrigation needs of the Temple premises.








Arjun street, being the main access to the temple, has been designed as a pedestrian street leading to the sacred stairs, Maha mantapam and the Shiva Temple. Arjun street is flanked on both sides by pergola covered pathways, granite patterned central carriageway with traditional lighting and landscaping.

This culminates at the grand stairway and ramp ways in front of Maha mantapam, providing massive seating areas for the pilgrims.

The grade difference between the lower waterfall area and Arjun street has been addressed through stepped planters and seaters in the approach way to Maha mantapam. The traditional, sacred stairway has been redesigned with lots of greenery and shade around with spiritual focal points.

The area around lower waterfall is the place for 'satsung' having a large lawn area with a open stage and a columnade backdrop offers multipurpose usage for pilgrims.

Where ghat road meets the southern gopuram is the "OM Court", adorned with OM fountain flanked by eight ornamental granite pillars giving the imagibility to the temple.

Complimenting this is the upper waterfall and the seat court for the light and sound program.

The centre with the large exhibition halls, open air theatre, expansive parking and landscape open spaces is a perfect avenue for large scale gatherings and sessions.







THE OVAL FOUNTAIN













The oval fountain with its high rise majestic fountain jets adorn the Entrance Court. which is further dramatised by a graciously sloping grass berm, further accentuated by the radial granite walls.

The main entrance to the building is highlighted by two mirror pools.

Lots of concrete had been broken down from driveways and parking bays to create patterned green pockets.

Seat courts with accent trees and grass paving have been planned wherever idle pockets were available, including fire exit paths.

Instead of concrete paving, local material granite was provided on sand bed to allow more greenery around as well as rain water recharge.



Vertical growing, evergreen tropical palms were preferred all along the glass facades.

Pergola sheltered breakout spaces with seater walls and lots of landscape around have been created all around the main building.

Large evergreen trees provide shade to these break out spaces, as well as cut down the radiation and heat Island effect on to the major glazed facades.








The automobile concept of 'Movement with Dynamism' continues to be expressed through the curved granite walls of the showroom garden.

The Ecopond collects the entire storm water from the site as well as the upstream areas through bioswales.


It not only acts as a resource reservoir for the site irrigation needs, but also as a sponge buffer for the downstream areas during monsoon times and avoids flooding.

The sunken court in the courtyard with the stepped seating and other landscape elements provides a cozy get together space.





TAPOVAN THE SILENT GARDEN

Tapovan is a farm villa gated community project promoted by the MARG Group based out of Chennai. TAPOVAN has been conceived as a 'Silent Garden' with a serene and tranquil environment.

The whole project is proposed to be built in two phases, the I phase to have 55 villas and the II phase to have the remaining villas, the park and the clubhouse. The landscape structure is completely of natural and sustainable elements like semi-pervious meandering pathways, eco-ponds, water channels, planting with local trees, plants and grasses. Storm water management of the entire site has been dealt with as per the natural gradient by means of open channels and grassed swales along the pathways. The park at the lower gradient of the site is to have an ecopond to collect, conserve and harvest the rain water from the water shed.




The Landscape materials are entirely natural and procured locally.

The two level pool created the possibility of a water fall onto the wading pool, made it very interesting for the kids to play with.

Stepped seatings and planting along with dense peripheral planting provides the seating for the party area around the pool.

The architectural planning cleverly avoided any vehicular movement around the central clubhouse, which paved the way for a variety of landscapes - seat court, play courts, garden cafe, bicycle ways, open air theatre and a continuos walkway.



THE COURTYARD

Inspired by the temple tanks, the terrace garden at the top of the clubhouse offers a sunken seat court with lots of social spaces around.

Each apartment block has a courtyard which has been completely exploited for the extensive play areas for the children and the well shaded resting spaces for the elderly.

The open side of the courtyard has been well screened by the raised earth berm against the parking areas on the other side.



The grade difference in the front court has been innovatively addressed through a subtle berm with a ramp.


